MATCHING DONOR FOR NEW CHURCH STEPS AND CLASSROOM WINDOW We have diocesan permission to raise funds for a new set of church steps (cost of about \$10,000) and a new school classroom window (about \$15,000). Plus we have a generous parishioner who will match what we raise up to \$12,500! Experts now tell us we can't repair the steps but need new ones. And we have been gradually replacing school windows and have one side of the building done. Watch for a new envelope that is coming out for this campaign.
